SUBJECT: The Disposal of Dog by the Municipality Number H-10

APPROVED DATE: May 10, 1996

EFFECTIVE DATE: May 10, 1996

PREAMBLE:

It is the intention of the Council of the Municipality of the District of Guysborough, wherever and whenever possible, to dispose of dogs taken under the provision of the Dog By-Law in the humanist method as possible.

TERMS:

1. The Municipality shall recover whenever possible all associated costs for the disposal of a dog from the owner of same.
2. When and if the Municipality is requested by the owner of any dog to dispose of a dog the individual shall pay in advance an amount equal to the estimated cost that could be incurred by the Municipality in the disposal of the dog and would include but shall not be limited to the following:
 - a) Veterinarian fees, if used;
 - b) Travel and related costs;
 - c) Burial fees
3. When disposals are requested by the owner of the dog an account will be forwarded to the owner for the total disposal costs less any deposit received prior to the disposal of the dog.
